## Saturday June 17th - Deffer Wood and beyond (7 miles)

The major part of this circular walk is in Deffer Wood. Anybody not familiar with the Wood and those who only know the main avenues that traverse it should be delighted with the beauty and character of these footpaths around what is a very special place. Short muddy sections may be encountered so stout footwear is recommended. On leaving Deffer via Spring House Farm the walk continues past Heald Head to reach Coach Gate Lane and Cuckold Farm.
